

COMBINED CONTRACT TENDER INVITATION

7. All Tenders must be accompanied by a Tender Security in the amount of US\$ 1,000.00 in one of the following forms:
 - (a) a bank guarantee or irrevocable letter of credit issued directly by a reputable bank, in the form provided in the tender documents, or
 - (b) a cashier's or certified cheque.
8. Tenders will be opened in the presence of the Tenderer's representatives who may choose to attend at the office stated above at 12:15 hrs local time on the **26th February 2010**.
9. In order to be eligible to Tender for each of the above contracts, Tenderers must clearly prove that they have previous experience in the provision, installation and commissioning of Civil, Mechanical and Electrical works, with a value not less than USD150,000.00 each or clearly prove that they have experience in equipment in allied processes of similar value and that their key personnel have the relevant experience.

A compulsory pre-Tender meeting followed by a site visit will be held on the **12th February, 2010** at 10:00hrs and all prospective Tenderers wishing to attend should meet at the **Municipality Of Chinhoyi Offices**. **Submissions by Tenderers will not be accepted unless they have attended the pre-Tender meeting.**
